## Bridge Walk for Reconciliation

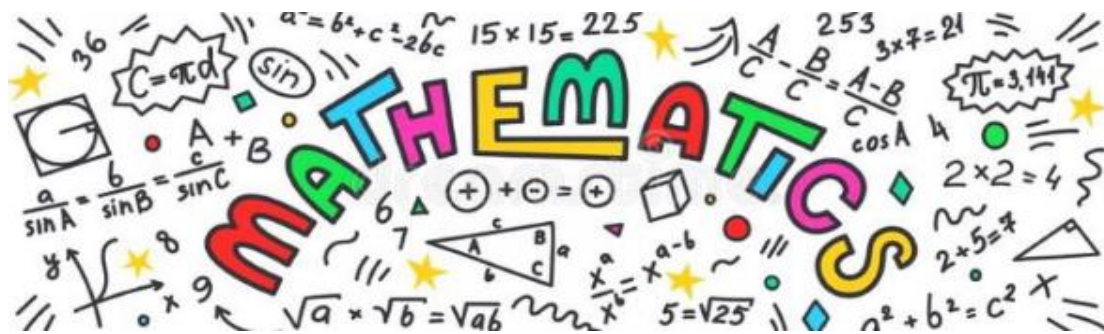
At the smoke ceremony you put smoke on your feet for the country we walk on.

Hopefully everyone was able to play a quick game of 'salute' over the past fortnight. If you have forgotten how to play, the description was in our Term Three, Week One newsletter.

This week, introduce your child to the fluency game called '45'. Simply use one suit set (Hearts, Clubs, Diamonds, or Spades) removing the picture cards. You will be left with an ace, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9. The ace being 1.

Randomly shuffle the cards and then begin flipping them over, adding each number together. Time each other daily to see how quickly you can add up all the cards. The more the game is played, strategies such as 'near doubles' (4 + 5), and 'friends of 10' become cemented in our minds, improving our fluency and number knowledge.

In maths this term, all grades are completing an inquiry cycle. In our PLC's (Professional Learning Communities) we have looked at, pulled apart and built our own pre assessment tasks with the Victorian Curriculum as a guide. Over the next couple of weeks, we will be refining these assessments and having the children complete them in order to gain their prior knowledge. The data will be looked at, units of work will be planned, taught and completed by the children. A post assessment then being completed that will allow us to see growth and further work required. We will be celebrating our children's work.
